

Free Class on How to Select, Plant, and Care for Trees and Shrubs (Woody Ornamentals)

The Hamilton County Master Gardener Association is inviting the public to attend a class on Wednesday evening March 28 from 6:30 to 9:30 and again Thursday afternoon March 29 from 1:00 to 4:00. Tree Committee Co-Chair Joe Stasey will teach the class to existing master gardeners to help them earn educational hours and the public to introduce them to the master gardener program. There is no charge for this class.

This class includes lots of practical information about selecting the right tree, shrub or vine. Joe will demonstrate the latest scientific technique on how to plant trees as well as how to mulch, water and fertilize them. You will learn how to prune shade trees, flowering trees, and shrubs. You will also learn how to recognize and eradicate some of our worst invasive plants and how to recognize and treat common problems affecting trees.
